

Rwanda's interim cabinet flees capital as rebels close in

KIGALI, April 12 (Reuter) - Rwanda's entire cabinet, appointed last week after the death of President Juvenal Habyarimana, fled the embattled capital on Tuesday as rebels tightened their noose on the city, witnesses said.

They said the 19-member interim government led by former parliamentary speaker Venat Theodore Sindikubwabo had fled to Gitarama, a town 40 kms (25 miles) southwest of the capital, as rebel forces of the Rwanda Patriotic Front (RPF) closed in.
