## SUBJECT: EVACUATION OF FOREIGN NATIONALS FROM RWANDA

Summary: 238 foreign nationals, including 204 Rwandans, were evacuated this morning to Bujumbura by air in two round trips.

- (1) The following (106) people were on the first flight:
  - Twenty-two members of the Russian representation in Rwanda, including the Ambassador
  - One diplomat from the Burundian Embassy in Rwanda and his family
  - Nine Rwandans from the Air France Agency in Kigali, who have already left on a Lufthansa flight to Nairobi
  - About 70 Rwandans, including the following personalities:
    - + Mr Sylvestre Nsanzimana, former Prime Minister and his family
    - + Mr Nrubito, Prosecutor General and his family
    - + Mr Ferdinand Nahimana, Minister designate for Higher Education and his family
    - + The wives and families of a number of ministers, including the Ministers of Planning, Higher Education and Youth
    - + The wife of the late FAR Chief of General Staff.
- (2) The second flight had 132 people on board:
  - Seven reverend sisters, including four Canadians, two Belgians, and one Spanish
  - One hundred and twenty-five Rwandan nationals, mostly senior government officials and their families. The Secretary
  - The MP cum Secretary of the National Assembly as well as the families of the Ministers of Employment and Health were also on board.

- 1. On arrival in Burundi, most of the above Rwandan refugees requested to leave, citing security concerns.
- 2. For their part, senior Burundian government officials appear to be particularly worried about the reactions of the Rwandan Tutsi community.
