I. GEN SITUATION. THE SITUATION REMAINS UNCHANGED. CALM

#### II. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

#### POLITICAL.

- (1) ON 161030 DEC 93 SRSG HELD A MEETING WITH THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS OF RWANDA AT THE SECRETARIAT OF THE BISHOPS CONFERENCE IN KIGALI. THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS PRAISED THE UN RESOLUTION 872 BUT EXPRESSED CONCERN OVER THE INTERNAL DIVISIONS OF THE POLITICAL PARTIES WHICH ARE SUPPOSED TO PROVIDE THE MEMBERS OF THE NEW BROAD BASED TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT.
- (2) IT IS REPORTED THAT THE FOLITICAL PARTY "PARTIE LIBERALE PL" IS SPLIT UP AND THAT EACH FACTION ESTABLISHED ITS OWN LIST OF MINISTERS AND MP'S. THESE LISTS ARE ADDED TO THE FORMER LIST ESTABLISHED IN THE PERIOD OF 37 DAYS AFTER THE ARUSHA PEACE AGRESMENT.
