BITREP COVERING PERIOD 130500Z APR TO 140500Z APR 94.

1. GEN SITUATION: WAR IS NOT OVER. THE UNCONDITIONAL CEASE FIRE PROPOSED BY RGF IS NOT EFFECTIVE. PROBABLY BECAUSE THE RGF IS DIVIDED INTO DIFFERENT FACTIONS AND THAT THERE IS NO OVERHAUL CONTROLLING AUTHORITY. ON 140530 APR 94 HEAVY FIRING ACTIVITY AND MOR SHELLING TOOK PLACE IN THE VICINITY OF THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE AND AT GIKONDO (INDUSTRIAL AREA OF KIGALI). FEW MOR SHELLS EXPLODED AT THE KIGALI INTERNATIONAL AIRFIELD. EVACUATION OF THE EXPATRIATES IS ALMOST FINISHED. THE FRENCH BATTALION LEFT KIGALI ON 121800 APR 94 AND THE BELGIAN BATTALION IS NOW CONTROLLING THE AIRFIELD. THE UNAMIR BELGIAN BATTALION IS YET TO LEAVE ITS POSITION TOWARDS KIGALI AIRPORT.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. PLANS ARE BEING MADE FOR THE REDUCTION OF THE MISSION OR EVEN THE WITHDRAWAL. ON 140800 APR 94 FC STATED THAT THE BELGIANS WOULD LEAVE THE MISSION SOONEST.

B. UNOMUR. THE UNOMUR OPERATIONAL AREA IS CALM. NTR.

C. DMZ. DMZ NO LONGER EXISTS. DMZ SEC HQ MOVED FROM BYUMBA TO NKUMBA. THE MOVE TOWARDS KIGALI IS PREPARED BUT NOT YET ORDERED. EXCEPT THE FORCE ENGINEER COY ALL DMZ TROOPS AREA STILL IN THE DMZ. A RECCE TEAM OF THE FORCE ENGR COY WILL GO TODAY TO BYUMBA IN ORDER TO FIND OUT IF THEIR EQUIPMENTS BEING LEFT BEHIND TWO DAYS AGO CAN BE RECOVERED.

D. SEC KIGALI.

(1) KIBAT. BELGIAN BATTALION HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN OF THE CITY. THE BATTALION IS MOVING TOWARDS THE KIGALI AIRPORT.

(2) RUTBAT. RPF IS IN A DEFENSIVE POSITION AROUND THE QUARTER OF THE BANGLADESH BATTALION (AMAHCRO STADIUM). THE NUMBER OF REFUGEES IN THE STADIUM IS INCREASING DAILY. THE ACTUAL NUMBER IS ESTIMATED TO BE 6,550. THE REFUGEES ARE FACING ACUTE SHORTAGE OF FOOD, WATER, MEDICINE, SHELTER AND SANITATION. HEALTH AND HYGIENE CONDITION IS IN SERIOUS CONDITION.

E. MILOB.

(1) MILOB GP HQ MILOB HQ ASSISTS IN THE EVACUATION OF EXPATRIATES AND CO-ORDINATES THE REDEPLOYMENT AND EVACUATION OF MILOBS. COMMUNICATION ENVIRONMENT IS VERY DIFFICULT. FEW UNAMIR CHANNELS ARE OPERATIVE AND THEY ARE SATURATED.
