- 1. GEN SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS STILL TENSE AND VOLATILE IN THE CITY. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE BATTLE SCENARIO WITHIN THE CITY. BOTH SIDES ARE PARTIALLY OBSERVING THE TRUCE. THERE MERE HXCHANGES OF FIRE BY BOTH SIDES DURING THE PERIOD IN THE CITY CENTER AND THE BASTERN PART OF THE CITY, HEAVY FIGHTING ALSO REPORTED IN RUHENGERI, NKUMBA, RULINDO IN THE NORTH AND AROUND BUGESERA IN THE SOUTH. UN SPECIAL ENVOY NOW SCHEDULED TO ARRIVE BY AIR LATER TODAY. FOUR SHELLS LANDED NEAR THE FORCE EQ DURING THE PERIOD. A VISIT CONDUCTED ON 23 MAY TO KANOMES CAMP REVEALED THE FOLLOWING:
 - A. SEVERAL DEAD ECDIES LAY IN FRONT OF A CHURCH AND A FRESHLY COVERED HOLE WHICH IS SAID TO CONTAIN 60 RGF DRAD SOLDIERS.
 - B. 15 DEAD BODIES OF RGF SOLDIERS WERE SEEN IN HOSPITAL MAIN BUILDING AND THEIR CONDITION INDICATED THAT THEY DIED 3/4 DAYS BARLIER.
 - C. AT CND AN ARMED BOY SOLDIER WAS SEEN IN RPF UNIFORM. HE IS ESTIMATED TO BE BETWEEN 13 AND 15 YEARS OLD.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. MR. RIZA AND MAJ GEN BARIL CONCLUDED THEIR DISCUSSIONS WITH THE RPP LEADERSHIP IN MULINDI AND RETURNED BY ROAD TO KABALE. DR. KABIA BRIEFED THE PRESS ON THE CURRENT SITUATION AND THE STATUS. OF NEGOTIATIONS TO THE EXTENSION OF THE TRUCE FOR AN ADDITIONAL DAY TO PACILITATE THE VISIT OF MR. RIZA.

3. PACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPP. RPF ARE STILL IN FULL CONTROL OF THE AIRPORT AND KANOMBE CAMP AND CONTINUE TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR POSITIONS: IN AND AROUND AREAS HELD IN THE CITY. EXCHANGED ARTY/MORTAR AND SAS FIRE WITH RGF TROOPS DURING THE NIGHT. SHELLED AREA OF CITY CENTRE AND EASTERN PART FROM GENERAL AREA OF MOUNT JARI. REPORTED TO HAVE ALSO EXCHANGED FIRE WITH RGF IN THE NORTH AND IN THE SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY.
- B. EGF. EXCHANGED FIRE WITH RPF OVERNIGHT WITHIN THE CITY CENTRE AND AROUND RUHENGERI, NXUMBA AND RULINDO IN THE NORTH AND BUGESERA IN THE SOUTH. BHELLITY CND, MERIDIEN HOTEL, FORCE HO AREA AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AREA DURING THE PERIOD IN RETALIATION TO RPF FIRE.
- C. MILITIA. CONTINUE TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN ROF CONTROLLED AREAS IN KIGALI CITY.
