SITREP COVERING PERIOD 011800Z JUN 94 TO 020600Z JUN 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION REMAINS TENSE AND UNPREDICTABLE. FIGHTING CONTINUED SOUTH OF GITARAMA IN THE GENERAL AREA OF RUHANGO, IN KIGALI CITY HEAVY EXCHANGE OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAS FIRE BETWEEN RPF LOCATED BETWEEN CND AND MERIDIEN HOTEL AND RGF TROOPS AT KYCHIRU, CITY CENTRE AND KIMIHURURA. FIRING BY RPF HAS ALSO BEEN REPORTED AT GADDAFI CROSSING FROM MOUNT JARI. 3 X MORTAR BOMBS HIT THE TARMAC AT KIA BETWEEN 012055 AND 012059 JUN 94. LOW MORALE AND DESERTION OF RGF SOLDIERS CONTINUES. RPF IMPOSING RESTRICTIONS OF UN PERSONNEL VISITING SOME AREAS UNDER THEIR CONTROL. THE CANADIAN DELEGATION IS VISITING SOME REFUGEE CAMPS THIS MORNING AND ALSO HOLDING A MEETING WITH THE RGF COBBERPONE HIS DEPARTURE LATER IN THE DAY. SECOND TRIPARTITE CEASE FIRE MEETING BETWEEN RPF AND RGF TO BE CHAIRED BY DFC IS SCHEDULED FOR THIS MORNING. EFFORTS ARE BEING MADE FOR BOTH WARRING PARTIES TO OBSERVE A TRUCE DURING THE PERIOD OF THE MEETING AND TO FACILITATE THE SAFE MOVEMENT OF THE CANADIAN DELEGATION.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. RADIO RWANDA IS APPEALING TO ALL RWANDESE TO STAND UP AND DEFEND THE CAPITAL. THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS IS ALSO REPORTED TO BE PROMISING WEAPONS TO THE YOUTH TO USE IN MANNING THE ROAD BLOCKS. THE ERSG IN STILL IN ADDIS ABABA FOR TALKS WITH THE OAU SECRETARY GENERAL.

3. FACTITIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO EXCHANGE ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAS FIRE FROM MERIDIEN HOTEL LINE TO KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA AND CITY CENTRE. ADVANCE WESTWARDS IN THE SOUTH CONTINUES AND FIGHTING IS REPORTED IN THE GENERAL AREA OF RUHANGO. IMPOSING RESTRICTIONS ON MOVEMENT OF UN PERSONNEL IN SOME RPF CONTROLLED AREAS IS REPORTED. RPF CONTINUING TO SQUEEZE RGF POSITIONS IN THE CITY.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUE TO DEFEND KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA AND CITY CENTRE. GENDARMERIE MANNING ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN SOME PARTS OF THE CITY. CONTINUED EXCHANGING ARTY/MORTAR AND HMG WITH RPF DEPLOYED AROUND CND, HOTEL MERIDIEN LINE. MOVEMENT OF SOLDIERS TO THE SOUTH CONTINUES. STILL SHOWING SOME WILL TO DEFEND KIGALI.

C. MILITIA. CONTINUE TO MOVE SOUTH. REDUCED PRESENCE IN THE CITY NOW BEING OBSERVED.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED. FC HELD NORMAL BRIEFING WITH STAFFS AT 011900 JUN 94. HE DISCUSSED THE CURRENT SITUATION AND THE VISIT OF THE CANADIAN DELEGATION. SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS AND PREPARATIONS FOR THE SECOND TRIPARTITE CEASE FIRE MEETING TO BE HELD

LATER THIS MORNING WERE ALSO DISCUSSED. CANADIAN DELEGATION VISITING SOME REFUGEE CAMPS THIS MORNING.

B. UNCOMBAT: AREA OF OPERATION IS CALM. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.

C. RYUBAT: CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. 3 X MORTAR BOMBS HIT TARMAC AT KIA BETWEEN 012255 AND 012259 JUN 94. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES TO OWN TROOPS. PROVIDED PROTECTION TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND KIA. CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG RUNWAY BETWEEN 0122000 AND 0123000 JUN 94.

D. 7TH PLATOON (+): PROVIDED SECURITY TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT HOTEL MERIDIEN, HOTEL MILLES COLLINS AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. OBSERVED HEAVY EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SA FIRE BETWEEN RPF POSITIONS LOCATED ALONG CND/MERIDIEN HOTEL LINE AND RGF POSITIONS AT KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA AND THE CITY CENTRE.

E. MILON: REORGANISATION FOR PHASE I DEPLOYMENT CONTINUES.

5. UNCIYPOL: 15 OF THEM ARE STILL IN NAIROBI.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM, AND OTHER LOCATIONS CONTINUE AT A SLOW PACE DUE TO LIMITED WATER, MEDICAL AND FOOD SUPPLIES AND THE CURRENT SECURITY SITUATION. TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO SECURE AREAS IS STILL SUSPENDED DUE TO SECURITY SITUATION.
