## SITEMP COVERING PERIOD 051800B JUN TO 060600B JUN 94.

- THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM IN KIGALI GEW SITUATION. OVERNIGHT. SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF FIRE BETWEEN THE ROP AND RGF CONTINUED IN KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTRE. PIGHTING IS REPORTED TO BE CONTINUING IN SHYORONGI IN THE NORTH AND AROUND GITARAMA IN THE SOUTH. THE EXODUS OF SOLDIERS, MILITIA AND CIVILIANS TO THE SOUTH CONTINUES. THE GENDARMERIE CONTINUES TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF HELD ARBARS IN THE CITY. RPF CONTINUES TO MAINTAIN A HARD GRIP ON RGF POSITIONS WITHIN THE CITY. THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PROPLE REMAINS SUSPENDED DUE TO SECURITY REASONS AND LOGISTICS PROBLEMS. FLIGHTS PROM NAIROBI TO KIGALI REMAIN EUSPENDED DUE TO SECURITY REASONS. THE CONTINUED FIGHTING IN THE COUNTRY IS RESULTING IN AN EVER PROPLE REQUIRING MORE INCREASING NUMBERS OF DISPLACED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE INTERIM GOVT IS HOLDING ITS CABINET MEETING AND HAS EXPRESSED DEEP CONCERN ABOUT THE INCREASING NUMBERS OF DESERTERS FROM THE RGF. THE RWANDAN CRISIS IS ON THE TOP AGENDA FOR THE GAU MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE STARTING IN TUNIS TODAY.

## 3. YACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. PPI THE RPF CONTINUES TO ISOLATE AND TAKE A FIRMER GRIP ON RGF POSITIONS IN KIGALI. CONTINUING TO PRESE TOWARDS GITARAMA IN THE SOUTH. EXCHANGED ARTY/MORTAR AND HMG FIRE WITH THE RGF AT KYCHIRU, NYAMIRAMBO, KIMIHURURA, THE CITY CENTRE AND AROUND GADDAFI CROSSING. EXCHANGED FIRE WITH THE RGF AROUND SHYORONGI AND BASE IN AN ATTEMPT TO RETAIN CONTROL OF THE ROAD PROM KIGALI TO RUHENGERI. NO MAJOR CHANGES REPORTED IN DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH.
- B. RGY: RGF CONTINUE TO REPLY TO RFF FIRES WITH ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SA'S FIRES IN THE CITY. CONTINUE TO CONSOLIDATE: THEIR POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA, MYAMIRAMBO, THE CITY CENTRE AND GITARAMA IN THE SOUTH. EXCHANGED FIRE WITH THE RPP AT SHYORONGI TO THE NORTH OF KIGALI AND BASH. BLEMENTS OF THE GENDARHERIE CONTINUE TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGP AREAS IN THE CITY.
- C. MILITIA. NUMBERS OBSERVED TO HAVE DWINDLED IN THE CITY IN RECENT DAYS.

### 4. ONE MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE NO. NORMAL ROUTINE ACTIVITIES WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC HELD NORMAL BRIEFING WITH STAFFS AT 051900. PLANS TO START USING THE ALTERNATE AIRHEAD IN VIEW OF THE CURRENT INSECURITY ARE IN PROGRESS.

- B. UNDAUE. AREA OF OPERATION IS CALM, MOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.
- C. EYURAT. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM, AND FORCE HQ. ALSO PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PROPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO. CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG RUNWAY BETWEEN 060300 TO 060405 JUN 94.
- D. TUN PLATOON (+). PROVIDE SECURITY AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MILLE COLLINS HOTEL, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.
- E. MILON PHASE 1 DEPLOYMENT FOR THE KIGALI SECTOR HAS COMMENCED.
- 5. UNCIVEOL, 15 ARE STILL IN NAIROBI.
- 6. TURNITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PROPLE TO MORE SECURE AREAS REMAINS SUSPENDED DUE TO INSECURITY AND LOGISTICS PROBLEMS. FIGHTING ALL OVER THE COUNTRY IS RESULTING IN AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF DISPLACED PROPLE WHO ARE IN DIRENBED OF HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE.
- 7. CIVIL AFFAIRS. NIR.
- 8. LOGISTICS. THE FORCE IS RUNNING OUT OF FURL AND RATIONS DUE TO THE SUSPENSION OF THE RESUPPLY FLIGHTS. ARRANGEMENTS ARR HOWEVER IN PLACE TO USE ENTEBEE AIRPORT AS AN ALTERNATE AIRHEAD AND MOVE THE SUPPLIES BY ROAD TO KIGALI.
