BUTREP COVERING PERIOD 131800Z JUN TO 140600Z JUN 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE PERIOD WAS GENERALLY CALM BUT SAW SPORADIC EXCHANGES BETWEEN THE TWO WARRING PARTIES IN NYAMIRAMBO, KYCHIKURU AND THE CITY CENTER. THE RPF CONTINUED TO ISOLATE AND PUT PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS. RPF CONTINUING TO CONCENTRATE THEIR EFFORTS TO ISOLATE KICHIKIRU, NYAKABANDA, KIMIHURURA, GIKONDO AND THE CITY CENTER AS THE RGF CONTINUES TO FIGHT BACK. GENDARMERIE AND MILITIA/INTERHAMWE CONTINUE TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE BATTLE SCENARIO IN THE NORTH. RPF IS REPORTED TO BE IN CONTROL OF GITARAMA. A HIGH INFLUX OF REFUGEES IS REPORTED IN CYANGUGU FROM KIGALI, GITARAMA AND BUTARE. THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PEOPLED WILL CONTINUE THIS MORNING. THE TRIPARTITE CEASE FIRE TALKS CONTINUES TODAY. THE TALKS WILL BE CHAIRED BY THE DEPUTY FORCE COMMANDER.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: THIS RWANDESE CRISIS REMAINS HIGH ON THE OAU HEADS OF STATE MEETING IN TUNIS. MEMBER COUNTRIES WILL BE DISCUSSING HOW TO CONTRIBUTE THEIR EFFORTS TO RESOLVE THE CRISIS. THE SECURITY SITUATION IN BURUNDI IS DETERIORATING RAPIDLY.

3. FACCTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO SQUEEZE RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIKIRU, NYAKABANDA, NYAMIRAMBO, GIKONDO AND THE CITY CENTER. FIGHTING IS REPORTED TO BE GOING ON AROUND GITARAMA. NO CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH. MORALE OF TROOPS APPEARS TO HAVE SOARED AFTER THE REPORTED CAPTURE OF GITARAMA.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUING TO RETALIATE TO RPF FIRE WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SAa FIRE AS THEY CONTINUE TO DEFEND THEIR POSITIONS WITHIN KIGALI CITY. REPORTS CONTINUE TO INDICATE THEIR LOSS OF GITARAMA TO THE RPF CONTROL.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA/INTERHAMWE CONTINUE TO FIGHT ALONG SIDE RGF. JOINT CONTROL OF ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS ALSO CONTINUED WITHIN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS.

4. OMN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. DPC HELD THE ROUTINE STAFF BRIEF AT 131900 JUN 94. THE PROGRESS OF THE CEASE FIRE TALKS WAS DISCUSSED. THE NEXT ROUND OF TALKS IS SCHEDULED FOR TODAY.

B. UNCOMBAT. AREA OF OPERATION REMAINED CALM. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.

C. GRANBATT. KIA GENERAL AREA WAS CALM. CONDUCTED

PATROLS AROUND THE KIA GENERAL AREA BETWEEN 2000 HRS AND 2400 HRS AND FROM 0410 HRS TO 0520 HRS. CONTINUED SECURITY DUTIES AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND KIA.

D. TW PLATOON (+). AREA OF OPERATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM. PROVIDED SECURITY AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MILLE COLLINS HOTEL, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.

E. MILOB. A MILOB ESCORT TEAM LEFT FOR KAGITUMBA WITH PERSONNEL PROCEEDING TO NAIROBI. TWO MILOB TEAMS CONTINUE TO MONITOR REFUGEE CAMPS AT STE FAMILLE. TWO TEAMS ARE ALSO ATTACHED TO THE MSF.

5. UNCIVPOL. ADVANCE PARTY COMPRISING 5 MEMBERS ARRIVED FROM NAIROBI YESTERDAY.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO SAFE AREAS IS SCHEDULED TO CONTINUE TODAY. THE VACCINATION OF DISPLACED PEOPLE AT AMAHORO STADIUM CONTINUES TODAY. THE FIGHTING IN KIGALI AND GITARAMA IS FORCING MANY ALREADY DISPLACED PERSONS TO FLEE TO CYANGUGU IN THE SOUTH WESTERN END OF THE COUNTRY.
