SITREP COVERING PERIOD 270600Z JUNE TO 271800Z JUNE 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM. SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SA8 FIRE CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE DAY. RPF CONTINUED TO ISOLATE RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU, VILLAGE URUGWIRO, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DEPLOYMENT OF BOTH WARRING PARTIES HAVE BEEN REPORTED WITHIN KIGALI. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES ARE STILL ON THE INCREASE IN RGF AREAS. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THE SITUATION IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE FRENCH ARE REPORTED TO BE CONTINUING THEIR DEPLOYMENT IN THE WESTERN PART OF THE COUNTRY. 50 PATIENTS WERE EVACUATED DURING THE DAY FROM THE RED CROSS HOSPITAL TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. THE GHANAIAN MILITARY DELEGATION ARRIVED THIS AFTERNOON FROM NAIROBI VIA NTEBBE. THE FC PRESENTED UNAMIR MEDALS TO GHANBATT TROOPS AT A SHORT CEREMONY AT THE KIA, A CEREMONY WHICH WAS ALSO ATTENDED BY THE VISITING GHANAIAN MILITARY DELEGATION.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE CIVILIAN POPULATION IN THE GOVERNMENT CONTROLLED AREAS OF KIGALI CONTINUE TO SHOW THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE FRENCH HUMANITARIAN SUPPORT IN RWANDA BY HOISTING THE FRENCH FLAG AT THE ENTRANCES OF HOUSES AND ON VEHICLES. RPF SYMPATHIZERS DISPLAYED PLACARDS DENOUNCING THE FRENCH INTERVENTION IN THE RWANDESE CRISIS.

3. TACTICAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED THEIR PRESSURE ON RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE IN KYCHIRU, GIKONDO, URUGWIRO VILLAGE, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER WITH ARTY/MORTARS, HMG AND SA8 FIRE. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS HAVE BEEN REPORTED.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR POSITIONS WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SA8 FIRE. CONTINUED TO OPERATE ALONG SIDE WITH THE MILITIA. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH. IN THE WEST THEY CONTINUE TO ASSIST FRENCH TROOPS.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES ARE STILL ON THE INCREASE. CONTINUED TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF AREAS. THEY ARE REPORTED TO BE CHANGING THEIR ATTITUDE TO THE FRENCH IN AREAS IN THE WESTERN PART OF THE COUNTRY.

4. OMN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. THE NORMAL STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED BY FC AT 0700 HRS. A SIX MEMBER GHANA MILITARY DELEGATION ARRIVED THIS AFTERNOON FOR A THREE DAY VISIT TO UNAMIR. THE

FC PRESENTED UNAMIR MEDALS TO GHANBATT TROOPS THIS AFTERNOON.

B. UNMOMU. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. CONTINUED TO COORDINATE MOVEMENT OF PERSONNEL FROM KIGALI TO ENTEBBE. BORDER CROSSING: 32 VEHs CROSSED INTO UGANDA FROM RWANDA WITH 147 PASSENGERS AND 17 WERE REFUGEES. 34 VEHs CROSSED INTO RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH 668 PASSENGERS OUT OF WHICH 459 WERE REFUGEES. 11 VEHs OF VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES ENTERED RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS.

C. GHANBATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT THE KIA AND THE STADIUM. TROOPS WERE PRESENTED WITH UNAMIR MEDALS BY FC AT SHORT CEREMONY HELD AT KIA. OWN MEDICAL STAFF PROVIDED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO 49 DISPLACED PEOPLE.

D. TUN PL. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN. ALSO PROVIDED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT HOTEL MERIDIEN AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.

E. MILOB. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE ESCORT AND MONITORING TEAMS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) MILOBS ESCORTED MSF PERSONNEL TO REFUGEE CAMPS WITHIN KIGALI AND ALSO ESCORTED ICRC TO EVACUATE CASUALTIES FROM RED CROSS HOSPITAL TO THE KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES TO AND FROM KAGITUMBA DURING THE PERIOD. THE LOGISTICS CONVOY THAT WAS TO BE ESCORTED FROM KAGITUMBA TO KIGALI DID NOT REACH THE RWANDA BORDER DURING THE PERIOD. THIS TASK IS RESCHEDULED FOR 28 JUN 94.

RESTRICTIONS THAT WERE IMPOSED ON UNMOMU IN MULINDI SECTOR HAVE NOW BEEN LIFTED BY THE RPF. PATROLLING WILL THEREFORE COMMENCE WITHIN THEIR SECTOR WITH EFFECT FROM TOMORROW.

5. UNCIYROL. ALL ARE NOW IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS REMAINED SUSPENDED DUE TO INSECURITY. THE FOLLOWING HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES WERE UNDERTAKEN TODAY:

A. 73 CARTONS OF HEB, 126 TINS OF SARDINES AND 4 CARTONS OF HB MILK POWDER WERE DELIVERED TO THE SISTERS OF CHARITY ORPHANAGE (STB FAMILLE).

B. AH TEAM VISITED NDERA CAMP AND IDENTIFIED REQUIREMENTS FOR FOOD, ANOTHER VISIT WILL BE CARRIED OUT TOMORROW TO

IDENTIFY MEDICAL NEEDS AND TO BRING IN SOME FOOD. THERE ARE ABOUT 200 ORPHANS IN THAT LOCATION.

C. THE VACCINATION CAMPAIGN BEING CONDUCTED AT KABUGA BY LOCAL MEDICAL STAFF IS NOW COMPLETED. THE SOME ACTIVITY WILL BE CONDUCTED AT NDERA CAMP IN A DAY OR TWO.

D. THE ICRC TRANSFERRED UNDER UNAMIR ESCORT, 45 PATIENTS FROM ICRC TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.

E. THE ICRC DELIVERED 44.5 MT OF FOOD TO 4,028 PEOPLE AT BUKARAGATA IN THE BYUMBA PREFECTURE.

F. THE ICRC HOSPITAL IN KIGALI ADMITTED 43 PATIENTS AND TREATED 73.
