I. GEW SITUATION. THE NIGHT WAS RELATIVELY CALM. THE GENERAL SITUATION HOWEVER REMAINS UNPREDICTABLE. SPORADIC EXCHANGE OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAE FIRE CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE NIGHT. THE RPF CONTINUED TO ISOLATE AND SQUEEZE RGF POSITIONS IN VILLAGE URUGWIRO, KYCHIRU CAMP, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER. RGF CONTINUED TO RETALIATE WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SAE FIRE TO RPF POSITIONS AROUND HOTEL MERIDIEN AND THE ROUND ABOUT. THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS WILL BE ATTEMPTED AGAIN TODAY UPON CONFIRMATION OF BOTH WARRING PARTIES TO OBSERVE A TRUCE DURING THE PERIOD. BRIEFING WILL BE CONDUCTED FOR THE GHANAIAN MILITARY DELEGATION THIS MORNING. THE TEAM WILL LATER VISIT TROOPS AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND KIA. THE FC DEPARTS THIS MORNING FOR NAIROBI VIA ENTEBBE. HE WILL LATER PROCEED TO GOMA (ZAIRE) TO MEET THE COMMANDER OF THE FRENCH TROOPS. THE PRENCH TROOPS ARE REPORTED DEPLOYED IN CYANGUGU, KIBUYE AND GISENYI. THEY OPERATE DURING THE DAY AND WITHDRAW ACROSS THE BORDER AT NIGHT.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: NTR.

3. PACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

- A. PPY. RPF CONTINUED TO TIGHTEN THEIR GRIP ON RGF POSITIONS BY IN THE CITY. THE MAIN AREAS OF SPORADIC EXCHANGES DURING THE PERIOD WERE KYCHIRU CAMP, VILLAGE URUGWIRO, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS HAVE BEEN REPORTED IN THE FRONTLINE.
- B. RGY: THE RGF CONTINUE TO RETALIATE TO RPF FIRES WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SAS FIRE TO POSITIONS NEAR HOTEL MERIDIEN AND THE ROUND ABOUT. THEY CONTINUE TO OCCUPY SOME DOMINATING FRATURES IN THE CITY, NO CHANGES IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS ARE KNOWN.
- C. MILITIA MILITIA/INTERHAMME ACTIVITIES ARE STILL ON THE INCREASE. CONTINUED TO MAN AND CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF AREAS AND THREATEN CIVILIANS.

4. OME MILITARY ACTIVITIES

- A. FORCE NO. NORMAL ROUTING WORKS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC HELD HIS STAFF BRIEF AT 1900 HRS. THE FORCE HQ RECEIVED A SIX MAN GHANAIAN MILITARY DELEGATION YESTERDAY. FC LEAVES THIS MORNING FOR NAIROBI.
- B. UNCHUR. AREA OF OPERATION REMAINS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.
- C. GHABBATT. AREA AROUND KIA REMAINS GENERALLY CALM, CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STREIUM. CONDUCTED PATROLS AROUND KIA FROM 2200 HRS TO 2300 HRS AND 0400 HRS TO 0500 HRS.

- D. TON PLATOCE (+). PROVIDED SECURITY TO THE DISPLACED PERSONS AT MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.
- E. MILCE. TWO ESCORT TRAMS LEFT THIS MORNING FOR KAGITUMBA TO ESCORT PERSONNEL PROCEEDING TO NAIROBI. TWO OTHER TEAMS WILL ESCORT RED CROSS CONVOY FROM KAGITUMBA TO KIGALI THIS MORNING.
