SITREP COVERING PERIOD 020600Z JULY TO 021800Z JULY 94.

1. GEN. SITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS COMPARATIVELY QUIET. HOWEVER SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF FIRES FROM INDIRECT AND FLAT TRAJECTORY WEAPONS CONTINUED IN KIGALI CITY THROUGHOUT THE DAY. RPF CONTINUED TO PUT PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER. AT 0800 HRS THREE SHELLS LANDED IN THE CITY MARKET CENTER KILLING 15 PERSONS AND INJURING 25. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DEPLOYMENT OF BOTH WARRING PARTIES WITHIN KIGALI. RPF ADVANCE TOWARDS BUTARE AND CONTINUED. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES CONTINUES IN RGF CONTROL AREAS. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THE SITUATION IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCE IS REPORTED TO HAVE WITHDRAWN FROM BUTARE TO GICONGORO. GOMA UNMO TEAM IS IN CLOSE CONTACT WITH FRENCH COMMAND AND RGF. SECTOR COMMANDER OF GISENYI STATED THAT IT WAS NOT ADVISABLE FOR MILOBs TO ENTER GISENYI FOR THE TIME BEING.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. SECURITY COUNCIL HAS PASSED A RESOLUTION FOR CONSTITUTING AN INFORMATION COLLECTION EXPERT COMMISSION. UN HAS ALSO ALLOWED THE COMMISSION FOR AN INTERNATIONAL COURT. THE COMMISSION HAS TO SUBMIT THEIR REPORT WITH IN NEXT FOUR MONTHS.

3. TACTICAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED THEIR PRESSURE ON RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE IN KYCHIRU, GIKONDO, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER WITH ARTY/MORTARS, HMG AND SA8 FIRE. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS HAVE BEEN REPORTED. INFORMATION REVEALS THAT RPF HAD A CLASH WITH FRENCH TROOPS AROUND BUTARE.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR POSITIONS WITH FLAT TRAJECTORY WEAPONS. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH. RPF Shelling AT MARKET AREA KILLED 15 PERSONS AND INJURED 25. IN THE WEST THEY CONTINUE TO ASSIST FRENCH TROOPS IN THEIR HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES ARE STILL ON THE INCREASE. CONTINUED TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF HELD AREAS.

4. ONE MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. FC HELD A MEETING WITH THE SENIOR STAFF OFFICERS AND DISCUSSED REGARDING THE FUTURE DEPLOYMENT OF EXPANDED UNAMIR. HE ALSO HAD A THOROUGH DISCUSSION WITH RPF SENIOR OFFICERS REGARDING UNAMIR ACTIVITIES.

B. UNCOMBAT: AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. CONTINUED TO COORDINATE MOVEMENT OF PERSONNEL FROM KIGALI TO ENTEBBE. BORDER CROSSING: 26 VEHs CROSSED INTO UGANDA FROM RWANDA WITH 123 PASSENGERS. 39 VEHs CROSSED INTO RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH 660 PASSENGERS OUT OF WHICH 289 WERE REFUGEES. 23 VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES ENTERED RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS. THREE HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.

C. GRANBATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT THE KIA AND THE STADIUM. THE BATTALION MEDICAL OFFICER TREATED 33 DISPLACED PERSONS.

D. TUN PL. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN. ALSO PROVIDED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT HOTEL MERIDIEN AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.

E. MILOB. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE ESCORT AND MONITORING TEAMS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) MILOBs ESCORTED MSF PERSONNEL TO REFUGEE CAMPS AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM.

(2) MILOBs CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES FROM KIGALI TO KAGITUMBA AND BACK, MILOB ALSO ESCORTED PERSONNEL, AND LOGISTIC CONVOY FROM KIGALI TO KAYONZA.

(3) MILOBs ESCORTED ICRC OFFICIALS TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL FOR EVACUATION THE CASUALTIES. EVACUATION DID NOT TAKE PLACE.

(4) MILOBs ESCORTED THE OFFICIALS OF UNICEF TO DELIVER FOODS TO THE REFUGEE CAMP AT NDERA.

AT ABOUT 1400 HRS 5 TRUCKS FULL OF YOUNG BOYS AND MEN OBSERVED MOVING FROM AKAGEBA PARK TOWARDS THE NORTH. THEIR DESTINATION WAS UNKNOWN. ABOUT 50 RPF SOLDIERS WERE OBSERVED MOVING FROM RWAMAGANA TO KIGALI.

5. FRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. THE FRENCH ARE DEPLOYED IN TWO GROUPS ESTABLISHING THE HQ IN GOMA. THE SOUTHERN GROUP IS LOCATED IN AND AROUND BUKAVU AND ENTERED RWANDA THROUGH CYANGUGU. THE NORTHERN GROUP ENTERED THROUGH GISENYI. THE FRENCH TROOPS REPORTEDLY HAS NOT ESTABLISH CONTACT WITH RGF AND RPF. THEY ARE ONLY FOLLOWING THEIR INTENTION TO CARRY OUT HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THEIR SUPPLIES ARE BROUGHT BY THE AIR EITHER FROM LIBREVILLE OR FROM THE CENTRAL AFRICA. MILOBs VISITED THE INSTALLATIONS OF THE FRENCH TROOPS IN GOMA AND OBSERVED THE FOLLOWINGS:

A. THE AIRPORT FUNCTIONING WITH THE FLIGHT CONTROL AND DISPATCH SYSTEM.

B. A FRENCH FIELD HOSPITAL LOCATED IN THE AIRPORT.

C. AN ENGINEERS UNIT OF FOREIGN LEGION.

D. ONE UNIT EQUIPPED WITH LIGHT ARMED VEHICLES.

6. UNCIWPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.

7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. HAC AND MSF WILL PREPARE A LIST FOR PROPOSED DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP IN GEN AREA KIGALI GOLF COURSE AND WILL FORWARD TO FRENCH HAC OFFICE IN GOMA TOMORROW. RFP HAVE NOT YET APPROVED OF PROPOSED CAMP IN THE GOLF COURSE. MSF HAVE APPROACHED HAC WITH A PROPOSAL TO SHIFT 100 TO 150 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM KING FAISAL HOSPITAL TO HOTEL MERIDIEN TO FACILITATE TO INCREASE MSF ACTIVITIES IN AN ANTICIPATION OF FUTURE TRANSFER FROM ICRC. FUEL DELIVERED TO ICRC AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. MSF HAVE BROUGHT DEFENSIVE STORES TO STRENGTHEN THE AREAS THEY USE IN FAISAL HOSPITAL. AH DELIVERED 12 BOXES OF BISCUITS AND 12 HEALTH KITS TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. ALSO DELIVERED 1 HEALTH KIT TO THE SISTERS OF CHARITY.
