SITREP COVERING PERIOD 030600Z JULY TO 031800Z JULY 94.

1. GEN. SITUATION. THE DAY WAS COMPARATIVELY QUIET. HOWEVER THE HOSTILITY BETWEEN THE TWO FACTIONS CONTINUED WITH LESS INTENSITY. RPF CONTINUED TO PUT PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU CAMP, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND CITY CENTER. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DEPLOYMENT OF BOTH WARRING PARTIES IN KIGALI. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES CONTINUES IN RGF CONTROL AREAS. THERE ARE NO CHANGES IN THE SITUATION IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES CONTINUED HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES WITHIN THEIR DEMARCATED OPERATION LINE IN WEST OF THE COUNTRY. ONE UNMO TEAM WAS TASKED TO GO TO THE RGF HQ ON LIAISON DUTIES. ON THE WAY TO THE CITY CENTER THE UNMO VEHICLE WAS FIRED NEAR THE SOPHCYA GAS STATION ON THE BOULEVARD DE L' OUA AT 1130 HRS. MAJOR S ANTONOV, UNID 708 OF RUSSIA SUSTAINED BULLET INJURIES. HE WAS EVACUATED TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. THE OFFICER IS PRESENTLY OUT OF DANGER. DFC HAD A DETAIL DISCUSSION WITH RPF SENIOR OFFICERS ON UNAMIR'S FUTURE REQUIREMENT OF ACCOMMODATION. RPF ACCEPTED MOST OF THE PROPOSALS. A HIGH LEVEL HUMANITARIAN DELEGATION LED BY MS GLYDNE EVANS, HEAD OF UN DEPT AT UK FOREIGN AND COMMONWEALTH OFFICE ARRIVED KIGALI THIS AFTERNOON. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED IN THE UNAMIR FORCE HQ BY FC, CHIEF OF OPERATIONS AND HAC. THE FIRST RECREATIONAL TRIP TO NAIROBI HAS STARTED TODAY BY SENDING TWO OFFICERS AND 30 SOLDIERS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE WEEK.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. RWANDESE PARLIAMENT WILL TAKE AN OATH IN GISENYI TOMORROW. ALL THE PARTIES WILL REPRESENT IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS EXCEPT RPF. PRESIDENT OF RWANDA STATED THAT IT IS NOW THE TIME TO FILL UP THE CONSTITUTIONAL GAPS. THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION ON BEHALF OF THE RWANDESE GOVERNMENT HAD DENIED THE ARRIVAL OF THE UN HUMAN RIGHT COMMISSION REPORTER IN THE COUNTRY. HE ALSO SAID THAT THE REPORTER DID NOT RECEIVE VISA FROM ANY RWANDESE EMBASSY SO HE CANNOT BE ACCEPTED BY ANY RWANDESE OFFICIALS.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED THEIR PRESSURE ON RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE IN KYCHIRU, GIKONDO, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER WITH ARTY/MORTARS, HMG AND S&B FIRE. RPF LAUNCHED A MAJOR OFFENSIVE ON RGF POSITIONS IN CAMP KYCHIRU EARLY THIS MORNING BUT NO SIGNIFICANT SUCCESS COULD BE ACHIEVED. HOWEVER THEY INFLECTED CAUSALITIES ON RGF SIDES. RPF KEPT ON POUNDING ON RGF POSITIONS IN MONT KIGALI AND KYCHIRU GENDARMERIE CAMP THROUGH OUT THE DAY. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS HAVE BEEN REPORTED. THE MORALE OF THE RPF TROOPS APPEARS TO BE IMPROVING AND NOW THEY ARE MORE OPTIMISTIC AND PROUD OF THEIR VICTORIES. HOWEVER THEY ARE RUNNING SHORTAGE OF FOOD SUPPLIES. MSF BELGIUM REPORTS IN A PRESS RELEASE THAT RPF HAVE ORDERED 50,000 TO 100,000 PERSONS TO MOVE OUT FROM NYANZA AND GO TO RELIMA. THEY HAVE ALSO ORDERED TO MOVE OUT 1500 PATIENTS FROM THE LOCAL

(1) MILOBS ESCORTED MSF PERSONNEL TO REFUGEE CAMPS AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM.

(2) CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES FROM KIGALI TO KAGITUMBA AND BACK. ALSO ESCORTED PERSONNEL, AND LOGISTICS CONVOY FROM KIGALI TO KAYONZA.

5. FRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. FRENCH TROOPS CARRIED OUT THEIR HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. 600 ORPHANS WERE EVACUATED BY FRENCH TROOPS FROM NORTH OF BUTARU. THEY WERE UPON FROM RPF LOCATION AND FRENCH TROOPS RETURNED THE FIRE, NO CASUALTIES. THE FRENCH TROOPS ARE AWAITING A REACTION TO THEIR YESTERDAY'S PROPOSAL TO SET UP A HUMANITARIAN NEUTRAL ZONE.

6. UNCIYPOK. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.

7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

A. HAC, MSF AND ICRC REPRESENTATIVE HELD A MEETING WITH THE COMMITTEE OF KING FAISAL HOSPITAL TO DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING:

(1) MOVEMENT OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO ACCOMMODATE WOUNDED PERSONS FROM ICRC.

(2) CONTROL OF THE DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD.

(3) CONTROL OF MEDICAL WASTE.

B. FOLLOWING DECISIONS WERE TAKEN IN THE MEETING:

(1) THE COMMITTEE WILL VACATE SOME DISPLACED PERSONS TO FACILITATE MSF ACTIVITIES IN THE HOSPITAL. HAC WILL OBTAIN A WRITTEN AGREEMENT FROM RPF IN THIS REGARDS.

(2) THE COMMITTEE WILL CONTROL FOOD DISTRIBUTION BASED ON ADVICE GIVEN BY THE AID AGENCIES.

(3) ICRC WILL ENSURE ALL MEDICAL WASTE ARE BURNED.

C. ADRA REPORTED ABOUT A LARGE NUMBER OF DISPLACED HUTUS MOVING BACK TO KIGALI FROM THE DIRECTION OF MONT KIGALI. IT ALSO REPORTED THAT RPF ARE FORCING A LARGE NO OF DISPLACED PERSONS FROM NYANZA TO RILIMA.

D. HFP HAS CONTACTED THEIR HQ TO DETERMINE THE NEXT ARRIVAL OF FOOD FOR KIGALI. ICRC DELIVERED 83 TONS OF FOOD TO 10,000 DISPLACED PERSONS IN RELIMA AND 79 TONS OF FOOD IN RUBHSKI FOR 7468 PERSONS. ICRC AIR LIFTED 70 TONS OF FOOD FROM NAIROBI TO GOMA. ICRC TREATED 49 PATIENTS.
