SITREP COVERING PERIOD 080600Z JULY TO 081800Z JULY 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. REPORTEDLY THERE WERE NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES OF MILITARY ACTIONS IN KIGALI WITH EXCEPTION OF PROGRESSING DEPLOYMENT OF RPF TROOPS IN VARIOUS MILITARY SECTORS IN THE CITY. SITUATION IN KIGALI IS CALM, HOWEVER THERE WAS SPORADIC GUNFIRE FROM THE KICUKIRO SECTOR. MR ARTURO HEIN, UNRWO COORDINATOR ARRIVED TODAY.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. SRSQ IS GOING TO MEET RWANDESE GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE AND RPF COS TOMORROW. MR FAUSTIN TWAGIRAMUNGU IS SUPPOSEDLY NOT RECOGNIZED BY INTERIM GOVERNMENT BECAUSE OF HIS TRIBAL STATUS.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPE. RPF CONTINUED TO MAN CHECK POINTS ALONG MAJOR ROADS IN THE CAPITAL. IN KIGALI CITY SURVEILLANCE OF THE REFUGEE CAMPS IN GIKONDO AND KICUKIRO AS WELL AS THE SECTOR ECOLE FRANCAISE NOTED. RPF INFILTRATED INTO THE HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE UPTO BIRAMBO. AFTER INTERVENTION BY UNAMIR THEY STOPPED THEIR ADVANCE.

B. RGE. CONSOLIDATION OF THEIR POSITIONS. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES REPORTED.

C. MILITIA. MANNING CHECK POINTS IN RPF HELD TERRITORIES.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. THE ROUTINE STAFF MEETING WITH THE STAFF OFFICERS TOOK PLACE AT 0700 HRS. FC CONDUCTED A RECCE OF AVAILABLE INFRASTRUCTURE IN KIGALI INCLUDING UNDP EDIFICE WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO BE HANDED-OVER TO ALL NGOs WORKING PRESENTLY IN FHQ BUILDING. AUSTRALIAN MILITARY RECCE TEAM LEFT TODAY FOR NAIROBI AFTER COMPLETION OF THEIR MISSION. SRSQ, FC AND SENIOR STAFF OFFICERS TOOK PART IN A SHORT FAREWELL CEREMONY OF THE TUNISIAN CONTINGENT AT KIA. A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT CAUSED SERIOUS INJURY TO CAPT ANTONY ANKAR OF GHANBATT. HE WAS EVACUATED TO NAIROBI BY AIR.

B. UNOMUR. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. BORDER CROSSING: FROM UGANDA TO RWANDA 70 VEHs AND 967 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 557 REFUGEES CROSSED THE BORDER, AND FROM RWANDA TO UGANDA 58 VEHs WITH 201 PASSENGERS. 86 GHANIAN PERSONNEL CROSSED INTO RWANDA BY THREE BUSES. 16 VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ORGANIZATIONS CONDUCTED THEIR ASSISTANCE OPERATIONS IN RWANDA. THREE HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.

C. GHANBATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM

(4) MSF WILL CONTACT WITH PSF IN ORDER TO RECEIVE INFORMATION ABOUT CONTENTS OF THE PSF STORE IN MUHIMA AND OBTAIN PERMISSION TO OPEN THE STORE IN ORDER TO DISTRIBUTE MEDICAL SUPPLY.

(5) THE TWO WOUNDED JOURNALISTS WERE EVACUATED TODAY BY AIR.

(6) HAC CONDUCTED PATROL TO WFP COMPOUND IN ORDER TO CHECK CONDITION OF 13 TRUCKS PLUS TRAILER AT THAT LOCATION.

(7) HAC REPORTS THAT RPF IS EVACUATED ALL REFUGEES FROM MILLES COLLINES.

(8) MAJ KAMANZI (RPF LO) INTRODUCED MAJ FRANK RUSAGARA TO HAC AS NEW RPF HUM LO.

(9) MR ARTURO HEIN WAS BRIEFED BY HAC ON CURRENT HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITY.

(10) HAC CONDUCTED RECCE OF UNDP BUILDING IN KIGALI. THE EDIFICE IS IN GOOD CONDITION AND SEEMS TO BE USABLE.

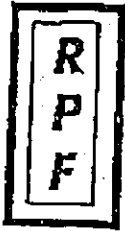
