SITREP COVERING PERIOD 121801Z JULY TO 131800Z JULY 94.

1. GRN SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS CALM THROUGHOUT ALL SECTORS OF KIGALI WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE SECTOR GIKONDO-ECOLE FRANCAISE-UNIVERSITY WHERE THERE WERE SOME SHOTS HEARD. DURING THE LAST THREE DAYS REDUCTION OF RPA SOLDIER STRENGTH HAS BEEN OBSERVED IN THE CITY. MANY DISPLACED PEOPLE CONTINUED TO RETURN TO KIGALI. HOWEVER THEY LACK FOOD THEREFORE CASES OF LOOTING WAS A COMMON SCENE. THE SITUATION OUTSIDE OF THE CAPITAL CONTINUED TO INTENSIFY IN THE NORTH AS RPF CONTINUED TO INCREASE THEIR PRESSURE ON RUHENGERI. ALMOST ALL CIVILIANS (300,000 PEOPLE) LEFT RUHENGERI FOR GISENYI AND GOMA DURING THE PERIOD. REPORTEDLY HUTU WERE COMING FROM BURUNDI AND ZAIRE INTO THE SOUTH OF RWANDA NEAR CYANGUGU. DEAD BODY OF CAPT ANTHONY ANKAH UNID B4513 IS SCHEDULED TO LEAVE KENYA FOR GHANA TODAY.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE MR FAUSTIN TWAGIRAMUNGU ARRIVES IN KIGALI TOMORROW. THIS WILL MARK A NEW DIMENSION IN THE POLITICAL SITUATION IN RWANDA. RPF IS LIKELY TO ANNOUNCE THEIR CABINET SOON. THE UNHCR SPECIAL ENVOY IS GOING TO VISIT KIGALI TOMORROW. IN HIS SHORT VISIT HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE CERTAIN REFUGEE CAMPS. THE FRENCH FOREIGN OFFICE DECLARED THAT 31 JULY IS NOT THE DEADLINE FOR FRENCH TROOPS TO WITHDRAW FROM RWANDA. THEY WOULD STAY UNTIL 22 AUGUST IN ORDER TO CONFORM TO UN RESOLUTION. RPA SPOKESMAN SAID THAT RPA DID NOT INTEND TO ACCEPT FRENCH TROOPS PRESENCE BEYOND 1 AUGUST. FRANCE PROMISED HELP FOR ALL LIVING IN HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE. MR ALEXEI KANYARENGWE DECLARED THE SAME TWO CONDITIONS OF CEASE-FIRE: STOPPING OF KILLINGS AND ARRESTING AUTHORS OF MASSACRES. THE FRENCH DEFENCE MINISTER DECLARED THAT BY THE END OF JULY FRENCH TROOPS THINNING OUT MUST BE EXPECTED, WHICH WOULD LAST UNTIL 22 AUGUST. ABOUT 300 REFUGEES DURING DEMONSTRATION TODAY ASKED FRENCH COALITION FORCES FOR HELP.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA. RPA LAUNCHED ATTACKS TOWARDS RUHENGERI: BOTH FROM THE NORTH AND THE SOUTH. THEY CONTINUED BOMBARDMENT OF RUHENGERI TOWN WITH MORTAR, ARTILLERY AND KATYUSHA FIRE, WITH THEIR INTENTION OF CAPTURING THE TOWN WITHIN THE NEXT DAYS AND PURSUE THEIR ADVANCE TO GISENYI. TO CONTROL KIGALI CITY AND ASSISTING DISPLACED PEOPLE TO RETURN TO THEIR HOUSES. CONTINUED TO PUT MORE PRESSURE ON RUHENGERI BY USE OF ARTILLERY AND MORTARS. NEW RECRUITS TRAINED IN KANOMBE ARE USED AT THE CHECK POINTS AND ON PATROLLING THE CITY. REPORTEDLY THERE ARE TWO INTERROGATING PLACES IN KIGALI AREA.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO WITHDRAW FOR SAFETY INTO GISENYI AND GOMA (ZAIRE). AT LEAST 5 RGF OFFICERS FROM RUHENGERI WERE SPOTTED TODAY LOOKING FOR ACCOMMODATION. ALSO SEVERAL MEMBERS OF INTERAHAMWE WERE SEEN IN GOMA. RGF ESCORTED OVER 30 RWANDESE BELIEVED TO BE FAMILIES OF

RWANDESE VIPs TO GOMA AIRPORT FOR ONWARD EVACUATION TO UNKNOWN DESTINATION.

C. MILITIA. THE INFUX OF INTERAHAMWE INTO GOMA MEANS THREAT FOR LO TEAM AT GOMA SINCE THEY RECOGNIZE UNAMIR AS THEIR ENEMIES.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC HELD BRIEFINGS TO STAFF AT 0800 HRS. THE CURRENT SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY AS WELL AS PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED WERE DISCUSSED. FC IS GOING TO LEAVE KIGALI FOR BUKAVU TOMORROW MORNING. HIS RETURN IS SCHEDULED TO BE TOMORROW NIGHT.

B. INOMUR. AREA OF OPERATION WAS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. DCMO VISITED LUBIRIZI, KASHEYKE AND MERAMA HILLS. POPULATION OF NEIGHBORING COUNTRIES MONITOR POLITICAL SITUATION DEVELOPMENT IN RWANDA ATTENTIVELY. BORDER CROSSING: UGANDA TO RWANDA: 66 VEHs, 491 PASSENGERS, 325 WERE REFUGEES. RWANDA TO UGANDA: 44 VEHs WITH 183 PASSENGERS, 10 WERE REFUGEES. ALL THREE HELICOPTERS ARE OPERATIONAL. 17 VARIOUS CHARITY ORGANIZATIONS WERE REPRESENTED IN RELIEF OPERATIONS IN RWANDA.

C. GHANBATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMARORO STADIUM, KING PAISAL HOSPITAL, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED ONE SECTION AND ONE APC FOR SECURITY DUTIES AT UNDP BUILDING. CONDUCTED PATROLS WITHIN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG RUNWAY FROM 2200 HRS TO 2300 HRS AND FROM 0400 HRS TO 0500 HRS. PROVIDED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO 25 DISPLACED PEOPLE WITH OWN MEDICAL STAFF. PROTECTION OF DISPLACED PERSONS AT MENTIONED LOCATIONS. 7 PERSONS OF REINFORCEMENT GROUP ARRIVED LOCATION BY ROAD FROM ENTEBBE AIRPORT. THE TRAINING ON APCs CONTINUED.

D. MILOR. PREPARATION AND PLANNING FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. PROVIDED ESCORTS AND MONITORING TEAMS TO UN AND OTHER HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES IN THE KIGALI CITY. COMMANDER RPA SECTOR TEAM AND THREE TEAMS PATROLLED BYUMBA AND KIGALI DISPLACED PERSONS CAMPS. THE SAME TEAM IS GOING TO CONDUCT EVACUATION TWO NUNS FROM BYUMBA TO KABALE TOMORROW.

5. FRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. ACCUSED UNAMIR LIAISON TEAM OF FURNISHING UNAMIR FHQ WITH FALSE INFORMATION ABOUT DEPLOYMENT OF A FRENCH TACTICAL HQ IN RWANDA. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN RELIEF AID TO DISPLACED PEOPLE. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES INTENTION IS TO PREPARE TO BE REPLACED BY UNAMIR UNITS FROM MID AUGUST.

6. INCIVPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.

7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THEIR ACTIVITIES REPORTED. ALL NGOs STAFF IN KIGALI MAINLY WAS ENGAGED

IN REMOVAL THEIR PROPERTY TO THE NEW RESIDENCE FORMER UNDP BUILDING. A FIRST CO-ORDINATION MEETING TOOK PLACE TODAY IN THE UNRWO OFFICE BETWEEN ALL THE RWANDAN AID ORGANIZATIONS (PRESENT IN KIGALI).
