RWANDA

INTERIM GOVERNMENT FORCES AND MILITIAS REPORTEDLY HAVE BEGUN TO STEP DOWN THEIR ATTACKS ON TUTSI CIVILIANS BEHIND GOVERNMENT LINES AND ARE SENDING THEM TO DISPLACEMENT CAMPS. SUCH A TURNABOUT COULD PRESAGE THE GOVERNMENT'S END-GAME AND ATTEMPTS AT IMAGE REPAIR FOR AN UPCOMING NEGOTIATIONS PHASE. (REUTER)

DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD SUPPLIES TO REFUGEES IN TANZANIA IS CONSTRAINED BY TRANSPORTATION PROBLEMS THAT PREVENT THE BUILDUP OF STOCKS.
