Evidence of complicity in Burundi troubles by Government of Rwanda.

On Sunday at around 0200 pm , a red Toyota - Land-Cruiser - crashed in an accident on Kigali-Kanombe road near the Capital of Kigali. The vehicle carried two different number plates but both of them had Burundi registration numbers. The front plate number was BR4911 while the rear one was Burundi Government registration number 78472.

The vehicle was carrying several ammunitions , land mines and some mortar shells. UNAMIR who were nearby at CND rushed to the scene and tried to handle the matter but received aggressive interference by Gendarmerie who whisked away to unknown place the two passengers who were in the vehicle. It was clear the action of Gendarmerie was panicky in an attempt to conceal the identities of the people who were in the vehicle.

Since the troubles in Burundi began in October 1993, the same vehicle had been seen under the control of Presidential Guard personnel.

What is more of concern to RPF is the continued meddling of Government of Rwanda, particularly the person of the President, in problems of neighbouring countries. This is odd diversion from Rwanda's troubles of which the President is the principal cause.
