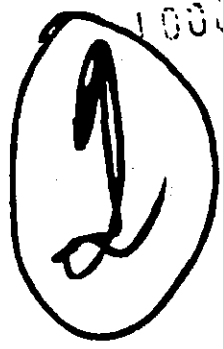

- 1. BELGIUM BN : NTR
- 2. BANGLADESH BN :

a. Total 1000 refugees took shelter at Amahoro Stadium till 1800 hrs today. The number of refugees are still on increase. There is an acute shortage of accommodation and food for the refugees. UNHCR may be approached immediately to arrange the accommodation and food for the refugees.

b. Bangladesh Battalion at Amahoro Stadium was under intense firing, most of the time. Two mortar shell had fallen within the compound of Amahoro Stadium and three mortar shell had fallen outside the compound of the Stadium.

c. RPF soldiers had taken up position at the outside perimeter of Amahoro Stadium.

3. TUN COY :

a. The TUN COY was also under fire most of the time.

b. Total 50 RPF soldiers had taken up position along the fence of the CND Complex.

c. One land cruiser jeep No- 1006 of TUN COY was shot by bullet and out of this two window glasses of the jeep were broken.

d. No food and drinking water available at CND for the troops of TUN COY. Combat ration and drinking water is immediately required for the troops of TUN COY.

e. One Night Vision Equipment of TUN COY was being from the RPF gate No- 2 since today morning. It is expected that RPF might had taken away the Night Vision Equipment.



5. MISC : On 081830 Apr 94, wife of one Belgium citizen was killed at her house at KIMIHURURA area by some unknown people.

6. GEN SIT : Fighting was taking place between the RGF and the RPF soldiers at different places in Kigali City like CND area, Amahoro Stadium area, Kimihurura area and Hotel Meridien area. Efforts were being made by the UNAMIR authority to bring a cease fire - agreement between the RGF and the RPF personnel.
