a. On 082100 Apr 94, two SMGs along with 50 rounds of ammunition were seized by Bangladesh Battalion from two custom officers at Amahoro Stadium. The custom officers were having valid permit for their weapons.

b. On 080700 Apr 94, one jeep of Bangladesh Battalion was hit by bullet while it was going to Force HQ. As a result of this, the windscreen as well as the right hand side door glass of the transport were broken.

5. MISC : On 090330 Apr 94, total ~~four~~ French C-160 aircraft at Kigali Airport carrying French troops and ~~one~~ French C-160, landed at 090600 Apr.
