2 We welcome Council reengagement with Rwanda, with Presidential statement as a first step. We have no problems with your draft.

3 We can go along with consideration of an arms embargo. In proceeding to negotiation of one (if it comes to that) key considerations should be that it be effective, practical and enforceable - which will require commitment by neighbouring countries. Their and OAU views on that would be helpful.
