Proposal for the meeting to be held concerning the Great Lakes region of Africa :

The meeting will be attended only by representatives of the following gouvernments: Burundi, Rwanda, Tanzania, Uganda and Zaire. Except for the facilitators, there will be no other participants or observers.

The facilitators are former presidents Nyerere of Tanzania, and Carter of the United States, and Archbishop Tutu of South Africa.

The meeting will be held in Cairo, Egypt, between November 28 and December 2, and The Carter Center will make arrangements for them.

The overall purpose of the meeting is to help ensure justice, peace, Cooperation and economic development in the Great Lakes region.

Other goals are t

- Working closely with the UNHCR and other international agencies, to expedite the orderly return of refugees to their home countries. All involved leaders will take decisive action within the refugee camps to elimanate and prevent any intimidation of refugees desiring peaceful repairiation.
- To prevent training and delivery of weapons to militia groups or any other groups among refugees.

- c) To help ensure the integrity of international borders by taking all available steps to prevent any armed incursions from one nation into another and by observing international conventions.
- d) To ensure that all nations will cooperate fully in the arrest and trial of all those who committed genecide as determined by international law.
- e) To seek solutions to related property and assets issues among governments in the region.
