SITREP COVERING PERIOD 120000Z FEB TO 130000Z FEB 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. CALM.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. BROAD BASED TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT NOT YET INSTALLED. NEGOTIATIONS ONGOING IN VIEW OF POSSIBLE SWEARING-IN CEREMONIES ON MONDAY 14 FEB 94. SEVERAL MEETINGS WERE HELD WITH PL, MRND AND MDR LEADERS AND PRIME MINISTER (DESIGNATE). ALL PARTY MEETING BEING HELD TODAY 13 FEB 94 UNDER SRSG'S PRESIDENCY.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

(A) RGF. DMZ SEC REPORTED THAT RGF INSTALLED A NEW CHECK-POINT AT MUKAMIRA (4732). OTHER CHECK-POINTS AT RUHENGERI AND GISENYU AREA ARE BEING REINFORCED AND CONTROL MEASURES ON CIVIL VEHICLES TRAFFIC ARE INTENSIFIED. ALSO RGF HELD UP TEMPORARILY AN UNMO TEAM AND ASKED FOR THE MISSION ORDER AT CHECK-POINT BETWEEN KABUMBA (3028) AND KAMIRA (3124). THE TEAM WAS ALLOWED TO CONTINUE ITS PTL AFTER SHOWING UN ID CARD. THE MATTER WAS PASSED TO RGF BYUMBA SEC COMD FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION. FROM 15.00 HRS TO 15.45 HRS ANOTHER TWO UN VEHICLES WERE STOPPED AT BUYOQA BY RGF. PERSONS WERE ALLOWED TO PASS AFTER INTERVENTION OF RGF BYUMBA SEC COMD. THIS CHANGE OF ATTITUDE BY RGF IS BEING INVESTIGATED BY FC WITH CHIEF OF ARMY STAFF.

(B) RPF. NTR.

(C) OTHERS. AS REPORTED IN YESTERDAY'S SITREP A CEASE FIRE VIOLATION OCCURRED ON 11 FEB 94 FROM 11.00 HRS TO 15.30 HRS IN THE DMZ AREA AT NYAMIREMBE (2448) ON THE BORDER BETWEEN RGF AND RPF. RGF AND RPF TROOPS FIRED INTERMITTENT. MILOB RPF SECTOR HQ REPORTED THAT ALL CASUALTIES WERE ON RGF SIDE. THREE RGF SOLDIERS KILLED AND FIVE INJURED. ALSO ONE CIVILIAN KILLED AND TWO INJURED IN CROSS FIRE. DMZ SEC AND MILOB GROUP HQ ARE CARRYING OUT FURTHER INVESTIGATION. DETAILS WILL BE FURNISHED ASAP. FC WAS ON SITE AND GAVE DIRECTION FOR INVESTIGATION.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. HQS. COORDINATION MEETINGS WERE ORGANIZED AT ALL LEVELS (FORCE HQ, KIGALI SEC, MILOB GROUP HQ) IN VIEW OF POSSIBLE SWEARING-IN CEREMONIES ON MONDAY 14 FEB 94. FC WENT TO NYAMIREMBE (2448), 30 KM NORTH-EAST OF BYUMBA, LOCATION WHERE THE CEASE FIRE VIOLATION OCCURRED ON 11 FEB 94. THE INFORMATION WAS PASSED TO MILOB HQ FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION. DFC IS VISITING UNOMUR FROM 11 FEB TO 15 FEB 94.

B. UNOMUR. THE SITUATION REPORTED TO BE CALM IN UNOMUR AREA. DFC'S VISIT IS EXECUTED AS PLANNED. THE FOLLOWING BORDER CROSSINGS WERE OBSERVED:

C. DMZ SECTOR. NO NOTICEABLE INCREASED ACTIVITY EVEN AFTER CEASE FIRE VIOLATION. CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PTL WITHIN OAR. FC VISITED DMZ HQ AND BYUBAT. BATTALION ADVANCE PARTY CONDUCTING DETAILED RECCES. ORDERS TO BE ISSUED

TOMORROW WITH INITIAL PAN-DMZ DEPLOYMENT COMMENCING MONDAY.

D. KIGALI SECTOR. AT 16.00 HRS A COORDINATION MEETING WAS HELD BETWEEN RUTBAT AND TUNISIAN COY COMD REGARDING REASSIGNMENT OF SECURITY TASK AT CND COMPLEX. SEC KIGALI CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT PTL IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA (KWSA). ESTABLISHED 3 CHECK-POINT DUTIES AT DIFFERENT PLACES IN KWSA. PROVIDED 2 UNMO ESCORTS FOR RPF, 1 FOR RGF AND 2 FOR GENDARMERIE. PROVIDED 1 ARMED ESCORT FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, 1 FOR THE BELGIAN AMBASSADOR AND 1 FOR RPF. SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RPF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY, THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE, FORCE HQ, SEC HQ AND KIGALI AIRPORT. FORCE HQ SECURITY WAS REINFORCED WITH ONE PLATOON DURING THE POLITICAL DIVISION'S MEETING. DURING THE NIGHT ASSURED PROTECTION OF THE PRIME MINISTER, THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT, FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS AND SRSG.

E. MILQ GP HQ. NO ESCORT DUTIES WERE CARRIED OUT BECAUSE OF NON AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES. (1) RGF SECTOR: CONDUCTED 3 FOOT PTL AT GISENYI AND REPORTED ABOUT 200 BORDER CROSSINGS BETWEEN RWANDA AND ZAIRE IN BOTH DIRECTIONS. (2) RPF SECTOR CARRIED OUT INVESTIGATION ON CEASE FIRE VIOLATION INCIDENT OF 11 FEB 94: INVESTIGATION ONGOING; (3) SOUTH SECTOR IS NOW OPERATIONAL AT BUTARE (7111) AND CYANGUGU (7725).
