- 1. GEN BITUATION: THE SITUATION STILL REMAINS TENSE AND PLUID.
 BOTH SIDES NOT SHOWING ANY SIGNS OF ABATING THE WAR. EXCHANGE OF
 ARTY/MORTAR AND SMALL ARMS FIRE CONTINUED BETWEEN RPF TROOPS
 LOCATED IN THE GENERAL AREA OF HOTEL MERIDIEN AND RGF TROOPS
 LOCATED AT KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA AND THE CITY CENTRE. RPF CONTINUE
 TO PRESSURIZE RGF FOSITIONS WHILE THE MILITIA CONTINUE FLEEING
 THE CITY SOUTHWARDS. EXODUS OF CIVILIANS ALSO CONTINUING.
 GENDARMERIES CONTINUINE TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF CONTROLLED
 AREAS WITHIN THE CITY. THE AGREED TRUCE, WHICH IS BEING PARTIALLY
 OBSERVED BY BOTH PARTIES HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 281800 MAY 94. THIS
 IS TO FACILITATE THE SMOOTH EXCHANGE OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO RPF

- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. POLITICAL EFFORTS CONTINUING TO FIND A LASTING AND WORKABLE SOLUTION TO THE RWANDAM CRISIS INTERIM GOVT SEEMS TO BE TONING DOWN ON SOME OF THEIR EARLIER PROMOUNCEMENT ON THE MASSACRES. THEY ARE NOW REQUESTING THEIR PEOPLE TO BE MORE TOLERANT TOWARDS TUTSIS.
