SITREP COVERING PERIOD 190600B JUNE TO 191800B JUNE 94.

- 1. GEM SITUATION. HOSTILITIES BETWEEN THE TWO WARRING PACTIONS IN KIGALI STARTED EARLY THIS MORNING WITH EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR AND SMALL ARMS PIRE WHICH CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE DAY. THE MAIN AREAS OF FIGHTING WERE IN KIMIHURURA, KACYIRU, KIMISANGE, KIYOVU AND THE CITY CHNTER. ONE SHELL LANDED WITHIN THE ICAC HOSPITAL KILLING ONE LOCAL STAPF AND WOUNDING SOME OTHERS. SOME SHELLS ALSO LANDED CLOSE TO HOTEL MILLES COLLING. THE RPF ADVANCE SOUTH CONTINUES TOWARDS KIBUYE IN THE SOUTHWEST OF THE COUNTRY. THERE ARE NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITIONS OF TROOPS IN THE NORTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE INFLUX OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO THE NORTH WEST TOWARDS GISENYI CONTINUES. THE EXERCISE ON THE TRANSPER OF DISPLACED PERSONS WAS SUSPENDED TODAY DUE TO SECURITY REASONS. THE HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM HAD AUDIENCE WITH THE RPF IN BYUMBA. ABOUT 400 ZAIROIS WERE EVACUATED TODAY BY THE RGF TO GOMA (ZAIRE) FROM KIGALI.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. RTLM HAS DENOUNCED THE SHELLING OF BILYOGO SUBURB OF KIGALI TODAY. THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT ALL RPF SYMPATHIZERS WHO SURVIVED THE SHELLING WILL BE KILLED BY THE MILITIA/INTERHAMME: THE DHBATE ON THE FRENCH INITIATIVE CONTINUES. MR BERNARD KOUCHNER MET THE CHAIRHAN OF RPF IN MULINDI TODAY.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPP. THE RPF SQUEEZE ON THE CITY CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE DAY. RGF POSITION IN KINIHURURA, KACYIRU NYAMIRAMDO AND THE CITY CENTER WHRE THE MAIN AREAS OF PIGHTING TODAY. THEY ARE REPORTED TO HAVE INFLICTED HEAVY CASUALTIZE ON THE RGF IN THE FIGHTING. THEIR ADVANCE IN THE SOUTH CONTINUES WEST TOWARDS KIBUYE. THE RPF IS REPORTED TO HE REINFORCING THEIR TROOPS AND BRINGING MILITARY SUPPLIES TO THE KIGALI. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN DISPOSITIONS IN THE HORTH.
- B. RGF. THE RGF CONTINUED TO DEFEND THEIR POSITIONS WITHIN THE CITY, THEY ARE REPORTED TO HAVE SUSTAINED HEAVY CASUALTIES IN TODAY'S EXCHANGES PARTICULARLY IN NYAMIRAMBO. THEY CONTINUE TO GRADUALLY LOSE GROUND TO THE RPF IN THE CITY AND TO THE SOUTH WEST. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THEIR DISPOSITION: IN XIGALI AND IN THE NORTH. INDICATIONS ARE THAT EFFORTS ARE NOW BEING CONCENTRATED AROUND GISENYI AND CYANGOGU.
- C. MILITIA. THEY ARE REPORTED TO HAVE FOUGHT SIDE BY SIDE WITE THE RGF IN NYAMIRAMBO TODAY. THEIR ACTIVITIES CONTINUE TO BE ON THE INCREASE IN RGF CONTROLLED ARRAS.

4. ONE HILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE TO NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED

DURING THE PERIOD, PC'S STAPP ERIEF WAS CONDUCTED AT 0700 HRS. MR BERNARD KOUCHNER HAD A MEETING WITH THE COS RGF AT HOTEL DIPLOMAT THIS MORNING, HE ALSO MET THE CHAIRMAN OF RPF AT MULINDI THIS AFTERNOON. THE PC ADDRESSED ALL BANGLADESHI OFFICERS AT THE AMAHORO STADIUM THIS AFTERNOON. THE EXERCISE ON THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS COULD NOT BE CARRIED OUT TODAY DUE TO THE HEAVY EXCHANGES OF FIRSWITHIN THE CITY.

B. INCMUR: A SIX MEMBER TEAM HEADED BY THE US AMBASSADOR TO RWANDA VISITED THE UNOMUR MISSION HO ON 18 JUNE 94. HE WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE DEFENCE ATTACHE ACCREDITED TO UGANDA AND A COLONEL FROM THE

PENTAGON. THE AMBRESADOR EXPRESSED HIS CONCERN ABOUT THE MOVEMENT OF ARMS INTO RWANDA THROUGH ZAIRE. ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. 46 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER INTO RWANDA WITH 608 PASSENGERS, 477 OF WHOM WERE REFUGEES. FROM RWANDA INTO UGANDA 46 VEHICLES CROSSED WITH 169 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 9 REFUGEES. TRAMS HAVE BEEN PUT IN PLACE TO FACILITATE THE EMOOTE MOVEMENT OF UNAMIR TROOPS AND EQUIPMENT THROUGH UGANDA.

- C. GEARRATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND PORCE: HQ. PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT THE KIA AND THE STADIUM. ESCORTS WERE ALSO PROVIDED FOR OTHER DUTIES DURING THE PERIOD.
- D. THE PL CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MERIDIEN HOTEL, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MILLES: COLLINS.
- H. HILOR: MILOB TRAMS WERE EMPLOYED FOR THE POLLOWING DUTIES DURING THE PERIOD:
 - (1) ONE TRAN ESCORTED MR KOUCHNER TO HOTEL DIPLOMAT TO MEET RGF COS.
 - (2) TWO TRAMS ESCORTED UNAMIR PERSONNEL FROM KIGALI TO KAGITUMBA AND RETURNED WITH THOSE COMING FROM NAIROBI THROUGH ENTERBE.
- 5. UNCIVEOL. THEIR INTEGRATION WITH THE MILOBS FOR THE TIME BEING HAS COMMENCED.
- 6. EURANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS COULD NOT BE CARRIED OUT TODAY DUE TO HEAVY PIGHTIMS IN THE CITY. THE UNICEF VACCINATION PROGRAM CONTINUED AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. HAC AND UN NGO REPRESENTATIVES WERE NOT ALLOWED TO GO TO KABALE FOR PREPARATIONS TO CARRY OUT HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS.
