## SITREP COVERING PERIOD 2318008 JUN TO 2406008 JUN 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION: THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS TENSE AND VOLATILE. HEAVY EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAS FIRE CONTINUED THROUGH OUT THE NIGHT BETWEEN THE WARRING FACTIONS. THE MAIN AREAS OF FIGHTING WERE AROUND KACHIYRU, KIMIHURURA, MERIDIEN ROUND ABOUT, VILLAGE URUGHIRO AND THE CITY CENTRE. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK PROM THEIR POSITIONS. SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF FIRE CONTINUED EARLY THIS MORNING BETWEEN RPF POSITIONS LOCATED NEAR MERIDIEN HOTEL AND RGF POSITIONS IN VILLAGE URUGHIRO. MILITIA AND INTERHAMME ACTIVITIES CONTINUE TO BE ON THE INCREASE. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THE SITUATION IN THE NORTH, RPF ADVANCE AROUND BUTARE IN THE SOUTH SEEMS TO BE STALLING. THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS FROM KIA TO THE KING FAISAL HOSPITAL WILL BE CONDUCTED TODAY. TWO MILOS TEAMS ESCORTED MR MEDILI, DIR FOD UN HO AND HIS TEAM PROCEEDING TO NAIROBI VIA ENTERES. THE FC WILL MEET COS RGF LATER TODAY. ELEMENTS OF THE FRENCH TROOPS ARE REPORTED TO BE ACROSS THE BORDER AND DEPLOYING IN THE WESTERN AREA OF RWANDA.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE RPF POLITICAL LEADERSHIP OF THE RPF IS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT THE FRENCH INITIATIVE IS AN INVASION AND WILL BE TREATED AS SUCH. RTLM HAS CONDEMNED THE DEMONSTRATION HELD IN BURUNDI AGAINST THE FRENCH INTERVENTION. THE MODERATE RHANDESE POLITICIANS WHO ESCAPED THE MASSACRES AFTER 6 APRIL ARE REPORTED TO HAVE FORMED A FRONT BY THE NAME " THE DEMOCRATIC FRONT FOR CHANGE." THE FRONT HAS CONDEMNED THE FRENCH INITIATIVE WHILE SUPFORTING THE CONTINUED OPERATIONS OF UNAMIR.

## 3. PACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RDY. THE RPF CONTINUED TO MOUNT PRESSURE ON RGF/PRESIDENTIAL GUARD POSITIONS IN KIMIHURURA AND AROUND VILLAGE URUGNIRO WITH ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAG PIRE OVER NIGHT AND THIS MORNING. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THEIR DISPOSITION IN THE NORTH: ADVANCE WEST WARD IN THE SOUTH SEEMS TO BE STALLING.
- E. ROY. SEEMS TO BE ABSORBING THE INTENSE RPF PRESSURE OVER NIGHT AND THIS MORNING AND CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK PROM THEIR POSITIONS IN KIMIHURURA AND VILLAGE URUGWIRO AND OTHER PARTS OF THE CITY. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH AS WELL AS IN THE SOUTH. PREPARATIONS FOR THE DEFENCE OF GISENYI AND BUTARE CONTINUING.
- C. MILITIA. CONTINUE TO CONTROL AND MAN ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN ROF HELD AREAS WHERE THEY CONTINUE TO BE A THREAT TO THE CIVILIAN POPULATION. JUBILATIONS OVER THE ARRIVAL OF THE FRENCH CONTINUE.

## 4. ONN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

- A. FORCE HO. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC HELD HIS STAFF BRIEF AT 1900 HRS. HE BRIEFED ALL ON THE OUTCOME OF THE DISCUSSIONS HELD WITH MR MEDILI AND HIS TEAM. MR MEDILI AND THE TEAM LEFT THIS MORNING FOR NAIROBI. THE FC IS SCHEDULED TO MEET WITH THE COS RGF THIS AFTERNOON. THE FC HAS MADE AN INITIAL CONTACT WITH THE PRENCH TROOPS BY TELEPHONE.
- B: OKONUR. AREA OF OPERATION REMAINS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.
- C: CHANGATT, AREA AROUND KIA WAS GENERALLY CALM. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM. CONDUCTED PATROLS AROUND KIA BETWEEN 2000 HRS TO 2100 HRS AND 0430 HRS TO:0510 HRS.
- D. TUM PLATOCM (+). AREA OF OPERATION REMAINED VERY TENSE DURING THE PERIOD. SOME SHELLS LANDED IN AND AROUND THE HOTEL MERIDIEN COMPOUND CAUSING SEVERE DAMAGE TO SOME SURROUNDING EUILDINGS. PROVIDED SECURITY TO THE DISPLACED PERSONS AT MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.
- B: MILON. TWO ESCORT THAMS LEFT FOR KAGITUMEA WITH PERSONNEL PROCEEDING TO NAIROBI, PREPARATION AND DEPLOYMENT OF MILOBS FOR PHASE 1 IS IN PROGRESS.
- 5. DECIVEOL. REORGANIZATION AND THEIR EMPLOYMENT CONTINUES.
- 6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS FROM KIA: TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL IS ECHEDULED FOR THIS MORNING.
- 7. CIVIL AFFAIRS. NIR.
- 8. LOGISTICS. NO CHANGE FROM LAST SITREP.
