SITREP COVERING PERIOD 300600Z JUNE TO 301800Z JUNE 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY QUIET. HOWEVER SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SA& FIRE CONTINUED IN VARIOUS PLACES IN KIGALI. THREE SHELLS EXPLODED NEAR THE CENTRAL MARKET KILLING THREE AND INJURING SEVEN. RPF CONTINUED TO PUT PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DEPLOYMENT OF BOTH WARRING PARTIES WITHIN KIGALI. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES CONTINUE IN RGF CONTROL AREAS. NO CHANGE IN THE SITUATION IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE FRENCH ARE REPORTED TO HAVE ARRIVED AT GIKONGORO AND STALLED 20 KMS SHORT OF THE RPF FRONT LINE. FRENCH DEPLOYMENT IN THE WESTERN PART OF THE COUNTRY CONTINUES. INFORMATION REVEALED THAT WESTERN TROOPS ADVANCING TOWARDS THE CENTER OF THE COUNTRY TO FIND DISPLACED PERSONS CAMPS AND MASS GRAVES. FC LEFT FOR GOMA (ZAIRE) TO MEET THE FRENCH COMMANDER. TWO M-113 APCs ARRIVED KIGALI THIS EVENING. THE GHANIAN MILITARY DELEGATION LEFT FOR NAIROBI AFTER THREE DAYS OFFICIAL VISIT UNAMIR.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. 1 JULY WILL BE THE INDEPENDENCE DAY OF RWANDA. PEOPLE DEMANDED THE PRESENCE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNMENT IN KIGALI FOR THE CELEBRATION. TANZANIA HAS BEEN CHOSEN FOR THE NEXT MEETINGS OF HEADS OF STATE IN THE SUB-REGION (MORUTU AND HIS "CHALLENGER" MUSEVENI, DANIAL ARAP MOI AND THE TANZANIAN PRESIDENT). THE FRENCH MINISTER OF DEFENCE EXPRESSED HIS CONCERN ON A LIKELY CONFRONTATION WITH THE RPF. ACCORDING TO SOME DISPLACED HUTUS, APPROXIMATELY 1000 TO 2000 ARMED PERSONS MOVED TOWARDS THE ZAIRIAN BORDER WHERE FRENCH HAS DEPLOYED THEIR SPECIAL FORCES. THE MINISTER STATED THAT THE FRENCH WOULD BE IN FAVOR OF FIGHTING SIDE BY SIDE WITH THE GOVERNMENT FORCES IF FRENCH ARE ATTACKED BY THE RPF.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED THEIR PRESSURE ON RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE IN KYCHIRU, GIKONDO, URUGWIRO VILLAGE, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER WITH ARTY/MORTARS, HMG AND SA& FIRE. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN DISPOSITIONS HAVE BEEN REPORTED. RPF CONTINUES TO FIRE SMALL ARMS SHOT DIRECTLY TO THE MERIDIEN HOTEL BUT NO CASUALTIES. RPF STATED THAT GOVERNMENTAL FORCES ARE TRANSPORTING ARMS AND AMMUNITION UNDER COVER OF A HUMANITARIAN OPERATION. BY NO MEANS "OPERATION TURQUOISE" CANNOT BE CALLED AS HUMANITARIAN OPERATION. THEY HAVE REMINDED FRENCH THAT IT WOULD BE BETTER FOR THE FRENCH NOT TO PENETRATE RPF LINES. RPF FIRED TOWARDS THE CIVIL PASSENGER AIRCRAFT TWICE WITH ANTI-AIR CRAFT GUNS THIS MORNING.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR POSITIONS WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SA& FIRE. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH. IN THE WEST THEY CONTINUE TO ASSIST FRENCH TROOPS.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES ARE STILL ON THE INCREASE. CONTINUE TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF AREAS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES:

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. TWO MILOB TEAMS ESCORTED UNAMIR PERSONNEL FROM KIGALI TO KAGITUMBA AND ESCORTED APCs AND FOOD CONVOYS FROM KAGITUMBA TO KIGALI. THE GHANIAN MILITARY DELEGATION LEFT FOR NAIROBI THIS MORNING AFTER THREE DAYS OFFICIAL VISIT. DFC VISITED AN ORPHANAGE THIS AFTERNOON.

B. UNOMUG. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. DCMO VISITED MERAMA HILLS. CONTINUED TO COORDINATE MOVEMENT OF PERSONNEL FROM KIGALI TO ENTIBBE. BORDER CROSSING: 45 VEHs CROSSED INTO UGANDA FROM RWANDA WITH 155 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 50 REFUGEES. 35 VEHs CROSSED INTO RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH 519 PASSENGERS OUT OF WHICH 439 WERE REFUGEES. 16 VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES ENTERED RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS. THREE HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.

C. GHANBATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT KIA AND THE STADIUM. THE BATTALION MEDICAL OFFICER TREATED 47 DISPLACED PEOPLE.

D. TUN PL. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN. ALSO PROVIDED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT HOTEL MERIDIEN AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.

E. MILOB. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE ESCORT AND MONITORING TEAMS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) MILOBS ESCORTED MSF PERSONNEL TO REFUGEE CAMPS AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES FROM KIGALI TO KAGITUMBA AND BACK. MILOB ALSO ESCORTED LOGISTICS AND APCs CONVOY FROM KAGITUMBA TO KIGALI.

(3) MILOBs ESCORTED ICRC OFFICIALS AND ASSISTED ICRC TO EVACUATE PATIENTS FROM ICRC HOSPITAL TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. DURING EVACUATION THE CONVOY WAS STOPPED BY THE RGF TROOPS NEAR KIGALI NIGHT CLUB BRIDGE. AFTER NEGOTIATION WITH RGF COMMANDERS, THE CONVOY WAS ALLOWED TO PROCEED FURTHER.

(4) FOUR MILOB TEAMS WERE TASKED TO EVACUATE 53 SICK PERSONS FROM ICRC HOSPITAL TO KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.

5. UNCIIVPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS REMAINED SUSPENDED DUE TO INSECURITY. HAC CITY PATROL WENT TO VISIT "NOTRE DAME DE CITRAUX". THEY FOUND 120 PEOPLE OF WHICH 60 ARE CHILDREN. THE NUN IN CHARGE WAS RELUCTANT TO ALLOW ANY UN PERSONNEL ACCESS INSIDE THE COMPOUND UNTIL A WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE PREFECTURE. THE FOLLOWING HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES WERE UNDERTAKEN TODAY:

A. AH TEAM DELIVERED 0.4 TONS UNAMIX, 0.4 TONS OF MAIZE, 2 BOXES OF HEM AND 144 BOXES OF HEB TO NYARUGENGE COMMUNE. DELIVERED 288 BOXES OF HEB, 0.7 TONS OF UNAMIX AND 0.8 TONS OF MAIZE TO PENTECOSTAL CHURCH. AH ALSO DELIVERED 144 BOXES OF HEB, 4 BOXES OF HEM, 0.8 TONS OF MAIZE AND 1 TONS OF UNAMIX TO CHINESE PUBLIC WORKS BUILDINGS.

B. VACCINATION CAMPAIGN CARRIED OUT AT NDERA. 189 CHILDREN WERE VACCINATED.

C. ICRC TRANSFERRED 53 WOUNDED PERSONS UNDER UNAMIR PROTECTION.

D. ICRC DELIVERED 35 TONS OF FOOD TO 5000 PERSONS IN SANZA. THEY DELIVERED 21 TONS OF MAIZE, 16 TONS OF BEANS, 2000 LTRS OF OIL AND 5000 KG SALT IN BUTARO. ALSO DELIVERED 85 TONS OF MAIZE, BEANS TO NGARA AND 105 TONS OF FOODS TO 9970 PERSONS AT MUKARANGE.
