SITREP COVERING PERIOD 111801Z JULY TO 121800Z JULY 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE SITUATION REMAINED CALM IN MOST OF PART OF THE COUNTRY EXCEPT IN RUHENGERI. IN KIGALI A FEW SHOTS WERE HEARD AT NOON IN GIKONDO. MANY DISPLACED PEOPLE CONTINUED TO RETURN TO KIGALI. HOWEVER THEY ARE EXPERIENCING FOOD SHORTAGES AND LOOTING IS TAKING PLACE IN SOME AREAS. THE SITUATION CONTINUED TO INTENSIFY IN THE NORTH AS RPF CONTINUED TO INCREASE THEIR PRESSURE ON RUHENGERI. HIGH INFLUX OF REFUGEES TOWARDS GISENYI AND GOMA WAS OBSERVED DURING THE PERIOD. THERE IS A REDUCTION OF RPF SOLDIERS IN KIGALI. JOURNALISTS WHO WENT TO GOMA RETURNED AS THEY COULD NOT LAND DUE TO BAD WEATHER. ONE TRUCK LOADED WITH FUEL, RATIONS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT ARRIVED FROM ENTEBBE. DEAD BODY OF CAPT ANTHONY ANKAH UNID B4513 LEAVES KENYA FOR GHANA TOMORROW. TRAINING ON APCs BY GHANBATT CONTINUED.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE MR FAUSTIN TAGWIRAMUNGO ARRIVES IN KIGALI TOMORROW. THIS WILL MARK A NEW DIMENSION IN THE POLITICAL SITUATION IN RWANDA. RPF IS LIKELY TO ANNOUNCE THEIR CABINET SOON.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO CONTROL KIGALI CITY AND ASSISTING DISPLACED PEOPLE TO RETURN TO THEIR HOUSES. CONTINUED TO PUT MORE PRESSURE ON RUHENGERI BY USE OF ARTILLERY AND MORTARS. HUTU POPULATION FROM RUHENGERI AREA ARE NOW FLEEING TOWARDS GISENYI AND GOMA. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE SITUATION HAS BEEN REPORTED FROM THE SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK IN RUHENGERI BUT THINNING OUT FROM THE BATTLE AREA. CONTINUED TO ASSIST THE FRENCH HUMANITARIAN FORCES IN THEIR TASKS WITHIN THE HPZ. HIGH INFLUX OF REFUGEES CONTINUED INTO GISENYI AND GOMA AS A RESULT OF THE FIGHTING IN RUHENGERI.

C. MILITIA. THEIR ACTIVITIES ARE CONCENTRATED IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS.

4. OHN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC HELD BRIEFINGS TO STAFF AT 0800 HRS AND 1800 HRS. HE DISCUSSED ABOUT THE CURRENT SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY. PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED.

B. UNOMUR. AREA OF OPERATION WAS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. PEOPLE IN UGANDA ARE WATCHING THE CHANGING SITUATION CLOSELY. THEY WELCOMED THE NEWS OF RPF GAINING CONTROL OF THE KIGALI AND BUTARE. BORDER CROSSING; UGANDA TO RWANDA 75 VEHs, 738 PASSENGERS, 546 WERE REFUGEES.

RWANDA TO UGANDA: 58 VEHs WITH 262 PASSENGERS, 22 WERE REFUGERS. ALL HELICOPTERS ARE OPERATIONAL.

C. GHAHBATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED ONE SECTION AND ONE APC FOR SECURITY DUTIES AT UNDP BUILDING. CONDUCTED PATROLS WITHIN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG RUNWAY FROM 2200 HRS TO 2300 HRS AND FROM 0400 HRS TO 0500 HRS. PROVIDED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO 20 DISPLACED PEOPLE WITH OWN MEDICAL STAFF. THE TRAINING ON APCs CONTINUED.

D. MILLOE. PREPARATION AND PLANNING FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. PROVIDED ESCORTS AND MONITORING TEAMS TO UN AND OTHER HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES IN THE KIGALI CITY.

5. FRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN RELIEF AID TO DISPLACED PEOPLE. A HIGH INFLOX OF REFUGEES IS EXPECTED INTO THEIR ZONE AS RPF CONTINUES TO SHELL RUKERNGRI.

6. UNCIYPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.

7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. UN AND OTHER HUMANITARIAN AID AGENCIES CONDUCTED A TOUR OF THE CITY TO ACCESS THE SITUATION AND CONDITIONS OF WARE HOUSES.

8. CIVIL AFFAIRS. NTR.

9. LOGISTICS. STOCKING IS CURRENTLY IN PROGRESS AND EXACT QTYS WILL BE COMMUNICATED LATER.
