Subject: Intelligence

1. At the request of Faustin Twagiramungu and after the mediation of the American and Tanzanian ambassadors, a meeting was held yesterday at 2300 hours. Firstly, the document written by the President and attached to the intelligence report of 11 February, was discussed. Twagiramungu was put under pressure not to avoid the problems within the MDR and to solve these before the installation of the GTBE. Twagiramungu promised to deal with this sensitive issue at the meeting on Friday. On Friday it will also be attempted to set a date for the installation. It is generally expected that tomorrow, the sides of Mugenzi and MDR Power (against Twagiramungu) who did not attend yesterday, will be present. Twagiramungu is said to be changing his position now he is slowly losing the support of a number of ambassadors (US, France and Tanzania) and Mr. Booh-Booh.
2. Contrary to the intelligence report of 16 February, there were not 1 but 3 fatalities as a result of the clash between FAR and FPR in the Mutara sector. MINUAR yesterday issued a communiqué about this without specifying on which side the victims fell.
3. Since 15 February the FAR chief of staff has put his military on alert. For example, this means that no furlough is permitted to the soldiers in the camps at Kigali, Kanombe and Gako. There have been more military exercises than normal. Since the beginning of this week, Radio Muhabura (the voice of the FPR), has reported the gathering of forces and weapons on the FAR side.

4. Faustin Twagiramungu and his MDR faction have planned a meeting this coming Sunday in the regional stadium in Nyamirambo, at 10:00 hours. It is widely assumed that Faustin is organising this meeting, after his court case, to show that he is still a political force and that he also has supporters. A pamphlet circulating in Kigali, particularly in the Nyamirambo area, is attached. It is a notice warning the Tutsis that if they come to the meeting on Sunday they will be photographed and traced and they will be dealt with.
