5. THE TANZANIAN FOREIGN MINISTER AND MPUNGWE REPORTED TO THE ARUSHA OBSERVERS ON APRIL 16 ON THEIR MEETINGS THIS WEEK WITH THE GOR AND THE RPF IN RWANDA. THE PURPOSE OF THE MISSION WAS FIVE-FOLD: TO PRESSURE BOTH SIDES TO SIGN A PEACE AGREEMENT, TO TAKE BOTH TO TASK FOR RUMOR MONGERING AND UNDERMINING CONFIDENCE IN THE ARUSHA PROCESS, TO VERIFY THE WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN (READ: FRENCH) TROOPS FROM RWANDA IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE DAR ACCORD, TO DISCUSS OAU CONCERNS ABOUT THE GOR'S LACK OF COOPERATION WITH THE NMOG, AND TO EXPLORE THE ISSUE OF MILITARY PERCENTAGES IN THE INTEGRATED ARMY.
